RULES & REGULATIONS

Registration

- Players to nominate/enter individually
- Players will be ranked 1-3 and 4-6 and play in these groups for the entirety of the tournament
- Players unable to play on both days need to identify that on the entry form and/or discuss it with the Registrar, Kathryn Larsen on - info@bvdistrictsbadmint.net
- Committee's decision is final

Playing

- Captains appointed by the committee
- Play will start at 9.00 am sharp on both days. All players to be in the Hall by 8.40 am for a meeting at 8.50 am on the Saturday.
- Warm up permitted for no longer than 5 minutes on first games and 1 minute on subsequent games (per round)
- Play will be 2 games to 15 points no setting
- Feather shuttles will be used.
- Play will be continuous – Captains to ensure the next pairing is ready to play prior to completion of the current match. Players to ensure that they are aware of when their next game is on so that they are ready.
- There will be no designated lunch break, players will need to make time individually for their lunch
- There will be allocated times for each round of matches.
- Whistle will be blown to start and finish rounds – if a game is incomplete when the finish whistle is blown enter the score at that time into the sheet with the team leading the score to be given the win.
- 5-minute transition between rounds – captains to organise
- Play will be scheduled to finish at 3.30pm Saturday and 1.30pm Sunday with presentation and raffle results after the Sunday finish. This may vary depending on the situation on the individual days
- It is intended that we will play 4.5 rounds on Saturday and the remaining 2.5 rounds on Sunday (based on 8 teams of 6). If possible, we will finish the 5 rounds on Saturday
- Necessary substitutions will need committee approval and the player subbing in must be of the same ability or lower based on initial ranking.
- 2 players can play in the one position and rotate if they are of the same standard (1 Entry fee will be charged in this situation)
- Any issues, in the first instance will be directed to the tournament administration –Murray Fanning and Jan McKenzie. If required, the tournament director - Garry Price - will be consulted.

Umpiring

- All games to be umpired
- First round – Team listed first umpires first
- Captains to supply umpires on an alternative game basis

Scoring

- Scoresheets to be signed by both Captains and handed to Admin at the completion of the rounds (2 sheets per round – 1 per team)
- Overall scoring is done on points won per round with the winning team of each match in the round receiving 15 additional points.

Post Tournament

- Feedback forms will be sent to players e-mails for input regarding areas for improvement and what players were happy with for consideration in 2024 and beyond
